Fun Fact

The First Indiana State Fair was held in Indianapolis on October 20-22, 1852. The First Gibson County Fair was held on the lawn of the Gibson County Courthouse in Princeton, on November 11, 1852. Livestock was exhibited and tied to the fence surrounding the court yard, and an effort was made toward a display of farm products of all kinds. In 1857, the Gibson County Horticultural and Agricultural Society purchased seven acres from Elisha Embree and moved the fair to the west side of town, its current location.
