- Awards & Prizes

- Contestants that place will receive a cash prize, personalized tote, sash, and crown.
- The number of placings on the Sweetheart's Court is TBD depending on number of contestants.

Pageant Format

 Gibson County Sweetheart contestants will be scored based on their ability to converse, speaking ability, poise, personality, and the judges' overall impression.

Preliminary Judging:

· Interview 50 percent of scoring

- Attire: Business Casual. Dress, suit pants & blouse, skirt & blouse.
- Each contestant will have one (1), three-minute interview with each of the three judges individually. Therefore, each contestant will give three separate interviews (9 collective minutes total), answering impromptu questions asked by each judge. Interviews are private and not open to the public.

On Stage Judging:

Personality Outfit 25 percent of scoring

- Attire: Outfit chosen by the contestant that showcases her personality. Ideas are on a first come first served basis.
- Props must be kept to a minimum and no additional music will be played.

Formal Wear 25 percent of scoring

- Attire: Cocktail Dress. Knee length, midi, and tea length are all acceptable. High-low gowns or any dress that touches the floor or shoes at any point is not acceptable.
- Contestants will answer an on stage question during formal wear.
- A dress with a very short hemline, a low-cut bodice and/or cut/design inappropriate for the Gibson County Sweetheart Pageant may be discounted by the judges.
